NASA's Jet propulsion Laboratory/Huntington Library

On March 20 and 21, Jan and Jeff Frederick led a run to NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory in Pasadena and the Huntington Library in San Marino. 29 SDMC members traveled in 15 Miatas and enjoyed top-down driving in some of the best weather we have seen in months.

Those participating were afforded the opportunity to learn the history of the Jet Propulsion Laboratory, its connection to both CAL Tech and NASA and to experience an up close and personal view of the operations controlled by JPL.

After a detailed briefing and a video, SDMC members toured the Space Vehicle Assembly Building and viewed the "Clean Room" where space vehicles such as "Curiosity" have been constructed. We also were admitted to the actual mission control room where all the NASA JPL vehicles that are in outer space are controlled.

The tour of JPL lasted 3 1/2 hours and was absolutely fascinating.

Following the tour of JPL, the group caravanned to Arcadia where we spent the night in a hotel. After breakfast the next morning, the group was treated to a driving tour of Arcadia, San Marino and Pasadena led by Steve and Laurie Waid. This is where they grew up and it was a great run through Steve and Laurie's old stomping grounds.

The group spent the afternoon in the magnificent Huntington Library and Botanical Gardens. SDMC





members wandered through the buildings viewing priceless art collections, Frank Lloyd Wright furniture, and rare book collections including Chaucer's Canterbury Tales and a copy of the Gutenberg Bible. We also wandered through the amazing collection of botanical gardens covering 120 acres and including over 14,000 different varieties of plants, which are growing in over a dozen garden areas.

Needless to say, these two destinations, JPL and The Huntington, were entirely different from each other, but both were considered interesting, educational, and enjoyed by all. Jan and Jeff were pleased that so many club members were able to join them on this educational run.



Changing our rules and regulations:

Change #1

Section 3.4.3 A (EXISTING)

A dual membership shall be entitled to only one printed copy of any news letter or other material distributed by the Club to the members.

Section 3.4.3 A (PROPOSED)

A dual membership shall be entitled to only one printed copy of material distributed by the Club to the member.

This simple wording change will allow SDMC to go to electronic newsletter

Change #2

Article X Dues and expenditures

Section 10.1 Dues- Membership dues shall be determined annually for either a dual or single membership to be effective the following year.

Section 10.2 Partial Year Dues-Partial dues shall be determined annually to be effective the following year.

Again, by eliminating the exact amount this will allow the dues to be set at any general meeting to be effective at the beginning of the following year.



- 7. Your SDMC membership will be verified. The verification and approval process may take several days.
