Miatas at Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca September 5-7

This year is the 25th anniversary of the Miata. The 1990 Miata was debuted at the Chicago Auto Show in February 1989 and went on sale in June of that year. In 1999, Mazda celebrated the 10th anniversary of the Miata with a party in Dallas, hosted by the Lone Star Miata Club. LSMC again played host in 2009 for the 20th anniversary celebration. A good number of San Diego Miata Club members traveled to each event and we all have terrific memories from our journey and participation. Despite the great distance, SDMC brought the highest number of Miatas of any club outside of Texas. For 2014, the 25th Anniversary

celebration is about 1,000 miles closer. And, once again, it's shaping up that SDMC will mount an awesome level of participation!

Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca is located about halfway between Monterey and Salinas in central California. This will be the fifth Miatas@MRLS event, and, by far, the most heavily attended. By the time this is published, there will be over 1,100 Miatas registered for the event. To my knowledge, that's already the largest gathering (ever) of Miatas in the United States. (So far, SDMC is responsible for 42 of those Miatas.) Miata enthusiasts are driving from as far away as the east coast and Canada to attend the event. So, why the big attraction? A few highlights:

 Guinness Book World Record Attempt - The current world record for number of Miatas in a parade is held by the Netherlands. The record was set in 2013 with 682 Miatas. At Miatas@MRLS, participants will attempt to break that record!

- Hot Laps A chance for racers and track enthusiasts to drive Laguna Seca at speed. In fact, the hot laps are mainly what previous Miatas@MRLS events have been all about. For 2014, organizers are working with Mazda to also make it the premiere 25th anniversary celebration. (Note: Hot laps are already sold out and there's a waiting list.)
- Parade Laps A chance for every Miata enthusiast to drive his or her Miata on the world famous racetrack! Yep, you'll get to experience the thrill of dropping down through the Corkscrew in the seat of your own Miata! In my opinion, this alone makes the event worth attending! (Note: Parade laps are done

behind a pace car and speeds are kept at a much tamer level compared to hot laps.)

- Complimentary BBQ dinners Friday and Saturday Night - Free food!
- Movie at the Track Mazda plans to erect a large screen at the track and show a movie on Saturday night.

Sound like fun? Wait, there's more... There will be guided tours of the Monterey area. Plus a Miata car show for participants, and Mazda will be bringing some of its historical and concept Miatas to show. And vendors will be on hand with product demos and event specials. All that, and much much more!

Say, did I mention that the event is FREE?! That's right, you can register as a participant for no cost, Mazda is footing the bill!

Hopefully, by now you're getting the idea that Miatas@MRLS 2014 is shaping up to be a hugely popular and extremely fun event! We will be making Miata history and, hopefully, setting a new World Record. I'm excited, and hope you are too!

If you aren't already registered to attend this awesome event, please point your internet browser to: http://miatasatmazdaraceway.com There you will find all of the current details and you can register in a few short minutes. Once you do register, please drop me an email to let me know (markbooth@cox. net).

Note: At the time of this writing, some of the details were still in flux. However, by the time this article is printed in "Twist and Turns" I expect all of the details to be finalized. If you've already registered (and booked your hotel), please pay close attention to any changes in the event schedule. Some of the latest scuttlebutt I've been hearing indicates that there might be good reason to arrive in the Monterey area earlier on Friday (September 5) versus later.

Also, it is expected that there will be a couple different caravans of Miatas from San Diego to Monterey. Details should be forthcoming (as we get closer to the event) via the club email list.

When the event was announced, my hope and goal was for SDMC to bring 40 Miatas to the event. We've hit that number so now I'm hoping we can raise it to 50! Don't miss this opportunity to have a whole lot of fun with your fellow Miata enthusiasts! I hope to see you there!

To be fair, this article is a last minute addendum to Mark's article on pages 1-3 that Mark wrote prior to Mazda's statements regarding the September 3rd press release.



Leather Seat Rejuvenation

Hello Club,

Over the last 54 years I have been using Lexol leather products for dried up old leather seats guite successfully. Recently I was working on some thirty five year old sun baked leather seats that were very dry and starting to crack. I realized that I needed something different than my old standby, Lexol. Something that will penetrate deeply and NOT leave a water proof barrier after the product dries in. I found two products at Tandy Leather Factory: Dr. Jackson's Hide Rejuvenator is a leather butter that goes on easily and soaks in deeply without leaving a barrier. I was able to apply multiple coats repeatedly and also do spotting, as certain areas dried in while other areas were remaining very moist. I have been moisturizing these seats and leather steering wheels for several days in succession. When I have saturated these seats I will then use the Lexol to establish a barrier to evaporative drying.

The Second product that I found is for SEVERE sun and weather protection. Aussie--Leather Conditioner made by Fiebing can be found at



Tandy's. This product is also a leather butter but has bees wax in it; and the dried barrier must be buffed in vigorously. I would use this product for leather that is constantly exposed to the elements.

I have found that I have better results using my hands, instead of a moist rag, to apply the leather butter and Lexol. The butter washes off with soap and water easily.

Other areas that I have had success with these products are: steering wheels especially near the 12:00 o'clock position that often crack from the sun, belts, Guitar straps, leather Bible covers, household furniture, stiff or brittle leather watch bands, and of course saddles and bridles. Do not use these on suede.

What I like about these three products is, they are nothing like the nuisance of saddle soaps with their hours of scrubbing, drying, cleaning, and repeating endlessly.

Hope that this is helpful and rewarding.
